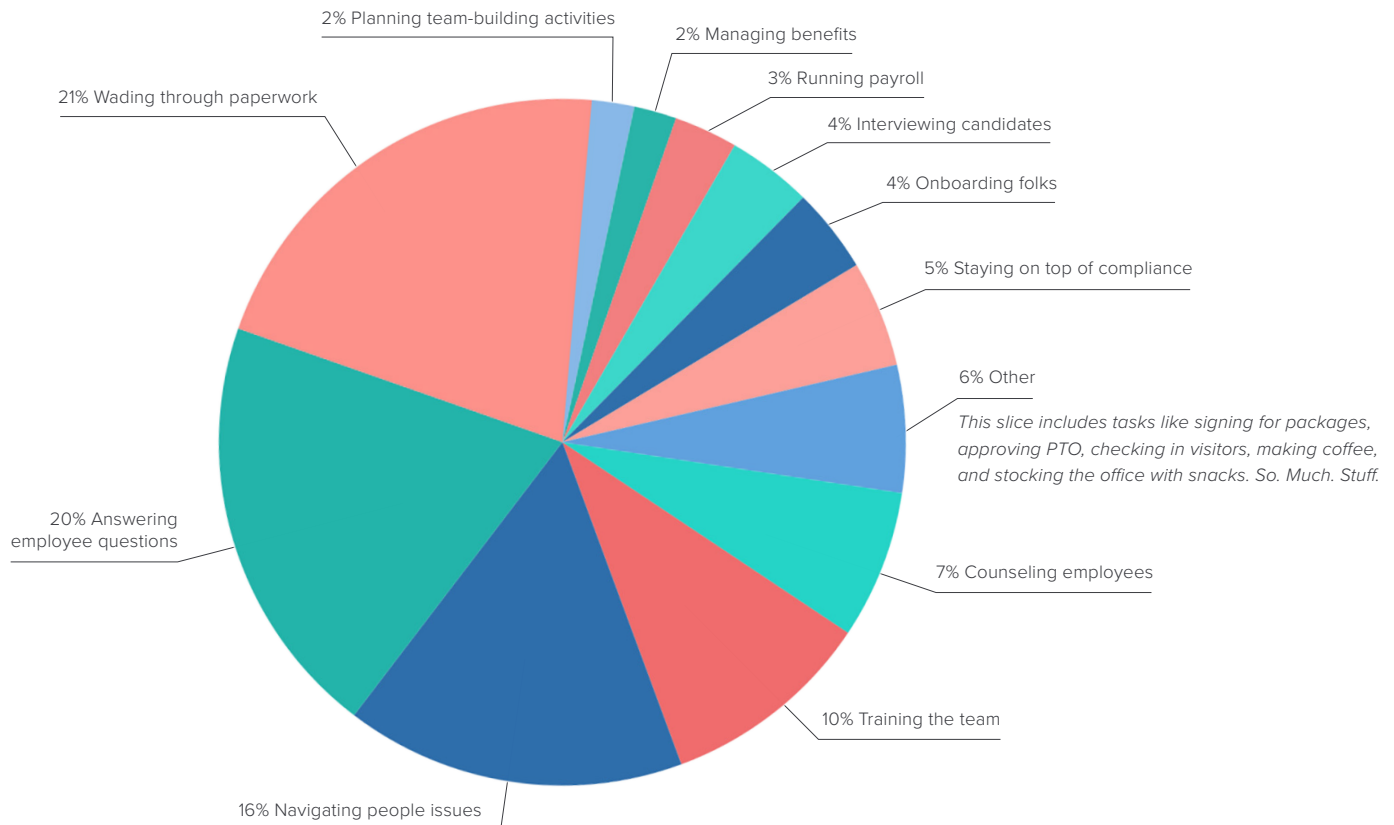


A day in the life of an HR pro
